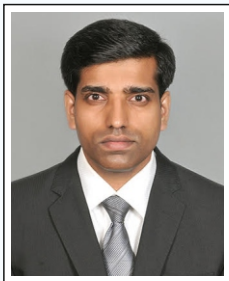

After graduation MBBS and MS, From Kasturba Medical College Manipal. Worked as lecturer, Assistant Professor in the Department of Cardiothoracic Surgery in Surgery in 1970 to 1973 during which time the first ever open-heart surgery in Karnataka was performed.

Further studies and the training in USA at University of Columbia, South Carolina University of Charleston and University of Tammises Memphis.

1980, Returned to India (Bangalore) and joined and worked as associate cardiothoracic surgeon during which he worked for a project “Juvenile Mitral Stenosis” funded a sponsored by department of Science of Technology, Government of India, New Delhi.

The Study involved screening, testing of 15,000 school going children, mostly in the rural areas around Bangalore for Rheumatic Heart disease. This also included treatment those children including mitral valve surgery.

1094 joined Hon Associate Professor and HOD of Cardiothoracic surgery and was responsible start and establish heart center with open heart surgical facility at Ramaiah Medical College Hospital.

He has to his credit to have performed first coronary bypass surgery in Karnataka State 1985.

Pioneered number of vascular surgery such as speno-renal shunt, Abdominal thoracic aortic aneurysms, A V Fistula for chronic renal failure.

Dr. NITHYANANDA SHETTY



Dr. Nithyananda Shetty was a dynamic young surgeon and an active member of the Surgical Society of Bangalore and a reputed Cardiothoracic Surgeon.

Born on 8th April 1952, Nithya was the fourth son of a family of agriculturalists. He completed his MBBS and MS Degrees from JJM Medical College, Davangere. He joined the department of cardiothoracic surgery at St Johns Medical College under Dr. Jerry Mascarenhas before moving to CMC Vellore to pursue higher Surgical training in Cardiothoracic Surgery and obtained MCh from CMC Vellore in 1985. He returned to Bangalore and joined St John's Medical College as Asst Professor in Cardiothoracic surgery and later on became the Professor and Head of the department in 1989. He resigned from the college in 1994 and joined MS Ramaiah Medical College as Head of the department, a post that he held till he breathed his last in 2004.

He was an excellent surgeon, very popular teacher and above all an extremely good human being. He made sure his presence was felt in the academic meetings he attended and did not hesitate to put forth his views while participating in a debate. Apart from the Surgical Society he was an active member of Association of Cardiothoracic Surgeons of India and Cardiological Society of India. He was recognized as a giant in the field of thoracic surgery and was well known for his work in peripheral vascular surgery. He was selected as the Starr Ahmed Fellow and delivered a masterly Godrej Karal oration in 2003. He performed innumerable number of operations both complex and complicated with very good results. His Patients loved him for his simplicity and straight forwardness. He was quite popular amongst his friends and colleagues and was a devoted family man.

His untimely death in 2004 left scores of individuals among the family and friends in a state of shock and grief. He was at the peak of his professional career and enjoying life with his family and friends when disaster took him away. His memory will always remain in our heart and mind. We will never forget his contribution to the profession and to the society.

PROF. B. HANUMAI AH

Dr. Hanumaiah was born on 1/10/1920 at Nelamangala taluk. He completed his secondary education in Magadi town following which he was encouraged by the government to carry on with his studies in medicine. He secured 1st rank in LMP conducted by the Medical School of Mysore state in 1941.

In 1946 he received Freemason Golden jubilee prize from His Highness Sri Jayachamarajendore Wodeyer the Maharaja of Mysore for having secured first rank in MBBS. He was deputed by the government to United Kingdom for higher studies in Surgery in 1953. He cleared FRCS from Edinburgh in first attempt in 1955. On his return he was appointed as resident medical officer at Victoria Hospital and thus began his long and illustrious career. He served as Associate Professor of Surgery at Bangalore Medical College in 1958 and was later moved to Mysore as Professor of Surgery. In 1966 he returned to Bangalore as Professor of Surgery and later on became the director of postgraduate studies in 1971. He became the dean and principal of Postgraduate Institute of Bowring Lady Curzon Hospital and also ex officio Superintendent of the hospital.

He was the member of Senate, Academic Council, and Chairman, Board of Examination, University of Bangalore. He was the Head of the department of Surgery of Bangalore Medical College till his superannuation in 1987. He was the recipient of Rajyothsava award by the Govt of Karnataka and Doctors Day award by the Indian Medical Association, Bangalore.

He attained heavenly abode on 08.03.1995.

Dr. Rajashekara Reddy whom we know as Dr. RS Reddy or VATS surgeon of Bangalore was born to humble agricultural family in 1970 in a small village Devangondi Hoshalli in Hosakote taluq, Bangalore rural district. He did primary and secondary education in government school in Kannada medium and literally learnt English from alphabets A B C D... from 8th standard onwards at Sri Ranganatha Rural high school in Kalkunte agharaha. He is eternally grateful for the dedicated teachers of the high school and that's the basis for what he is today. He had done all agricultural work along with studies till 10th standard and that knowledge keeps him strongly motivated to the success in his career. He is happy to be alumni of Bangalore medical college as he spent a decade in the campus of BMC, Victoria & affiliated hospitals during MBBS from 1988 to 1994 and again MS from 1995 to 1998. Also proud to say that he passed the FRCS from the Royal college of surgeons of Edinburgh in the first attempt. Perhaps the only exam he has failed in the first attempt was the IELTS (International English language testing system).

He was not sure of specialty to be pursued soon after MS. While delivering the duty as registrar after MS at a corporate hospital, he noticed the chest drain inserted by the qualified McH cardiothoracic surgeons was going in to the abdomen and pondered on why? This inquisitiveness made him to choose Thoracic surgery as specialty to practice and looked for the apt training. But unfortunately all of the accredited training Institutes in India -McH Cardiovascular & Thoracic surgery give only cardiac surgery training. Hence he learnt the art and skill of thoracic surgery from Tata Memorial hospital, Mumbai and then in minimally invasive surgery like thoracoscopy (VATS), mediastinoscopy in the UK. He is happy to be back in the own turf of Bangalore from 2004 onwards and enjoys the full, unconditional support of his teachers, friends here in the Bangalore and more so here in SSB.

He is a life member and a fellow of association surgeons of India (FAIS), Indian association of cardiovascular & thoracic surgeons (FIACS), one of the Founder member's of Indian society of thoracic surgeons & trust which was officially inaugurated only recently in 2017 and many other organisations like IMA, AMC. He is actively involved in teaching and training activities also as the Director of BMC alumni skills center. He has actively inculcated in the development of ECLS (emergency care life support), a unique life support hands on training for the doctors. This ECLS only university recognised (RGUHS) training program unlike others such as ATLS, ALS gives comprehensive training in all emergencies including trauma, cardiac events, poisoning, pregnancy related issues, child emergencies so that the doctor attending an emergency patient can confidently approach, resuscitate, document and transfer the patient safely. He is a Trustee of Jeeva Raksha Trust established to promote ECLS. It's needless to say he has good number of publications, presentations and a faculty in the regional as well as national meetings.

He is an editorial board member and section editor for thoracic surgery in the Indian journal of thoracic and cardiovascular surgery. He enjoys the work as a reviewer for the journals & has reviewed more than 400 manuscripts for several journals such as European Journal of Cardiothoracic Surgery (EJCTS) and Interactive Cardiovascular Thoracic Surgery (ICVTS), Indian Journal of Surgical Oncology (IJSO) and Asian Cardiovascular and Thoracic Annals. I was the Orator of the year 2017 for the prestigious Prof. Godrej Kari oration during annual meeting of Indian society of cardiovascular & thoracic surgeons.

He is married to Mrs. Rita Rajashekara Reddy (montessary school teacher) and proud father of Son Mr. Dhruv R Reddy (doing culinary arts degree) and daughter Ms. Jahnvi R Reddy (9th std).



Dr. M. AUTHIKESHAVALU

Dr. Muniswamy Authikeshavalu was born on 16th August 1906 at Bangalore. After completing a course in LMP he went on to do MBBS from Madras University where he was the best outgoing student. He was deputed to Canada where he obtained his fellowship (FRCS). He worked in Mayo clinic USA with a special interest in intestinal abstruction. after returning to India he joined Victoria Hospital in 1956. Later he became the principal and Dean of Bangalore Medical College. He is known for his Marathon Teaching sessions. He pioneered work on “Peptic Ulcer Treatment - Truncal Vagotomy and Gastro Jejunostomy”. His original research work is still preserved at Mayo Clinic. He retired in 1967 from Government service and joined CSI hospital, but continued to teach students from St. Johns Medical College. He was married to Achamma and has two sons and one daughter.

He succumbed to cancer of stomach in 1973.
